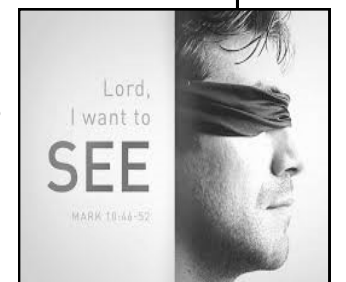

FEAST DAYS THIS COMING WEEK

27 Oct **St Otteran** was abbot of Meath and later went to Iona. He died in 548 and his grave on Iona was greatly revered. As a result the Vikings chose Otteran, the titular guardian of their ancestors' ashes, as patron of the city of Waterford in 1096.

28 Oct **St Simon** the Apostle was also known as "the Zealot." **St Jude** the Apostle was also known as Thaddeus. He is the patron saint of lost and desperate causes.

30 Oct **Blessed Terence Albert O'Brien**, Bishop, was born in Limerick in 1601 and entered the Dominican Order in 1622. His life coincided with a period of intense persecution of the Catholic faith in Ireland and he was executed on 30 Oct 1651.
